<b>Performance Standards and Reading Traits</b>	<b>Emerging:</b> Student requires ongoing support. The student demonstrates a <b>beginning</b> understanding of the concepts and competencies relevant to the expected learning. <i>“I don’t get it yet, but I’m trying; I am just getting started and learn best with help”</i>	<b>Developing:</b> Student may require some support. The student demonstrates a <b>partial</b> understanding of the concepts and competencies relevant to the expected learning. <i>“I’m starting to get it; I get some of it; I am beginning to do more on my own”</i>	<b>Proficient:</b> Student works independently.
